#1 ENL- Spring Pilot

FRIDAYS 2 PERIODS – 2 CLASSES

GOAL WOULD BE TO LAUNCH TO THE WHOLE SCHOOL

EXAMPLE: Ms Morgenstern 3rd grade G+T

Ms. Wine Creative art photographic

Based on Renzulli School Wide Enrichment model

Incorporate Parents talents and profession as a part of enrichment

Student council- launch newsletter

#2 CEP

Move to Improve: Met goal, superseded numbers

Math: Algebra for all, word problem solving

Showcase: 3rd all is going well.

Parent per Class: What are the Responsibilities? Position to be proud to hold

#3 COMMUNICATION

How to share information and reach class parents:

1 on 1 with teacher, reminder to class, develop contact list, Dojo or Class Remind

Sneak Peak: Letter piloting and defining, reminders, PTA point of contact, coordinating homework

Remind: App allows chat

Class Dojo: Class run management, reminders to group, not points related

Remind: Share Photos

#4 ELA- Prep and Testing

Homework policy, students can opt in

Grades 3-6 : Extra homework, 1 hour reading passage and writing assignments

Homework on weekends: Chancellor Prep

Teacher Test Prep on Friday: Test sophistication, how to write for test

20% Prep test, reading strategy; Format – skill practices for Higher level skills

#5 FIELD TRIPS:

Every grade has trips; Stagger types of trips; 5-6 Trips consistent for 4th grade

Example: Unit maps -NYC 1800s - Across the decades- tenement museum , class geared tours

Roosevelt Island- 2nd and 4th Grades

Fort Totten: Colonial

Teachers planning out the time, extra prep period needed to coordinate

Grade leaders of Teachers- execute the list of trips by the end of the school year

Need to review list of trips in June to align across the grades with Grade Leaders

#6 CAPITAL FUNDING:

Councilman has up to \$5m in Discretionary funds used for technology upgrades, science labs
