2017-18 CELL PHONE SCHOOL POLICY

Dear Parents,

Chancellors Regulation A-413 permits students to bring their cellular phones to school. Use of cell phones when school is in session may disturb the learning environment; therefore our cellular policy remains unchanged.

- Students may bring their cellular phones to school. They must keep them in their bags and off while they are on school premise.
- Anyone found with a cellular phone will be required to surrender the device to school personnel. The device will be returned to the student by the end of the day and a parent or guardian will be notified.
- If a student is found a second time with the cellular phone, a parent or guardian will be contacted and asked to come to school to pick-up the cell phone and meet a designated school personnel to review this policy.
- If there is a third violation, the cellular phone will be returned to the parent on Friday. The student will also face disciplinary action.

PLEASE NOTE- Cellular phones are not permitted during State testing. Consequently, all cellular phones will be collected and placed in a box. They will be returned at the end of the test.
